

**ORDINANCE NO. O-201-2017**

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH COUNCIL AMENDING  
SECTION 26-437(A) OF THE LAFAYETTE CITY-PARISH CONSOLIDATED  
GOVERNMENT CODE OF ORDINANCES TO PROVIDE FOR UPDATED  
STANDARDS FOR BACKFLOW PREVENTION AND CROSS-CONNECTION  
CONTROL**

**BE IT ORDAINED** by the Lafayette City-Parish Council, that:

**SECTION 1:** Section 26-437(a) of the Lafayette City-Parish Consolidated Government

Code of Ordinances is hereby amended to read as follows:

(a) Any consumer or other person who fails to comply with the latest revision of the International Plumbing Code, Backflow/Cross-Connection Control Requirements Sections as adopted by the Louisiana State Uniform Construction Code Council (LSUCCC), or who fails to comply with the additional requirements of this section or any notice or order made hereunder shall be in violation of this section.

**SECTION 2:** All ordinances or resolutions, or parts thereof, in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

**SECTION 3:** This ordinance shall become effective upon signature of the Lafayette Mayor-President, the elapse of ten (10) days after receipt by the Lafayette Mayor-President without signature or veto, or upon an override of a veto, whichever occurs first.


