LUS Announces 1 Million Work Hours Without A Lost Time Preventable Job Injury

LAFAYETTE, LA (August 18, 2020) – Lafayette Utilities System (LUS) has achieved a safety milestone of 1 million work hours without a lost time preventable job injury.

Between April 2019 and June 2020, LUS recorded the one-million-hour achievement through LUS employees' culture of safe practices and commitment to on-going workplace safety training. This due diligence is continuing to pay off as LUS is currently at 1.15 million hours without a lost time preventable injury.

"Our LUS employees are having to deal with some very dangerous situations every day. Plus, the fact that this is being achieved during the COVID crisis makes it that much more impressive. "
