

MAKE YOUR OWN COSTUME:

Electrical Engineer!

GLASSES: Clear safety goggles will work.

HARD HAT: Make it more realistic by printing out your public power utility's logo and taping it on the front!

T-SQUARE: Adding in this prop will help make sure your costume measures up!

SAFETY VEST: This is a two-fer, as it is part of the costume AND can help keep you safe while trick-or-treating.

BOOTS: Any boots will do, but styles with rubber soles or that look like work boots are even more authentic.

PLANS/DRAWINGS: Draw your own interpretation of the electric grid, a substation, or a generating facility on a large piece of paper, and then roll it up for easy carrying.

CLIPBOARD: Add any variety of relevant words or drawings to a piece of paper attached to the clipboard, such as a checklist of electrical safety tips or ideas for using energy more efficiently.
