### **Lafayette Utilities System Has Lifted the Boil Water Advisory Notification**

LAFAYETTE, LA– Lafayette Utilities System (LUS) has lifted the Boil Water Advisory for residents and businesses in the areas north of Willow Street, south of Gloria Switch Road, east of Roger Road, and west of Wilderness Trail – except for small areas of Lafayette Parish Water District North (WDN) customers located within these boundaries.

We are asking all residential and business customers to continue to assess their water lines for any leaks or breaks.
