LAFAYETTE UTILITIES SYSTEM HAS LIFTED THE BOIL WATER ADVISORY NOTIFICATION

LAFAYETTE, LA— Lafayette Utilities System (LUS) has lifted the Boil Water Advisory for residents and businesses in the areas north of Johnston Street, south of West Congress Street, west of Cajundome Boulevard, and east of Bertrand Drive.

Water samples collected by LUS under the guidance of the Louisiana Department of Health-Office of Public Health have been cleared.

After a boil advisory, customers should:

- Dispose of the next three batches of ice from ice makers
- Run empty dishwasher one time on the hottest or sanitize setting
- Unscrew faucet aerators, run water for 5 minutes then clean and reinstall the aerator
